HISTORY: The **George and Rosalie Hearst Fellowship in Ophthalmology** is a fellowship in perpetuity through the dedication and hard work of Dr. Kenneth Grow (Resident: 1951-54) and the generosity of the William Randolph Hearst Foundation. As a permanent endowment, the Hearst Fellowship in Ophthalmology will continue to contribute to the worldwide effort to prevent blindness and to foster good international relationships. The Hearst Fellowships begins circa 1967. They replaced the Heller Foreign Fellowships that went from 1951 to 1962. Edward Hellman Heller was a UC Regent and financial, civic and political leader; he was also a patient of Dr. Frederick C. Cordes. Because of Dr. Cordes' care, Mr. and Mrs. Heller generously helped establish the **Heller Foreign Fellowship**.

On the tenth anniversary of these Fellowships, these Fellows were and will be eligible for an invitation to return to give the annual George and Rosalie **Hearst Lecture** at the annual Frederick C. Cordes Eye Society annual Symposium. Travel expenses and lodging are provided.
